Horses and Cars

With the number of livery yards and riding school in the parish, it is inevitable that you will come across horses on the road. Riders would prefer not to use the road but we have only one short bridleway in the parish so here are a few tips for motorists and riders to help both parties avoid accidents.

Tips for Motorists

Be aware of horses and cyclists on our lanes particularly around bends

- be prepared to slow down and stop if necessary passing wide and slow without revving engine or sounding horn
- Treat horses as a potential hazard as they may react unexpectedly to things you cannot hear.
- Sometimes it is safer to ride in double file if the inside horse is young or nervous or ridden by a

•if the rider needs to keep both hands on the reins for control they can still nod or smile to thank you for yourcourtank you for your courtsey

Tips for Riders

- Wear reflective gear so you and your horse can be seen
- Avoid riding in poor light or fog
- Give clear and accurate signals and read the appropriate part of the highway code.
- do not ride more than 2 abreast or take a green (young) horse onto the road without an experienced steady escort.
- Lead on the left hand side of the road with yourself between the led horse and the traffic.
- Acknowledge and return courtsey with a smile and a nod if your hands are full
